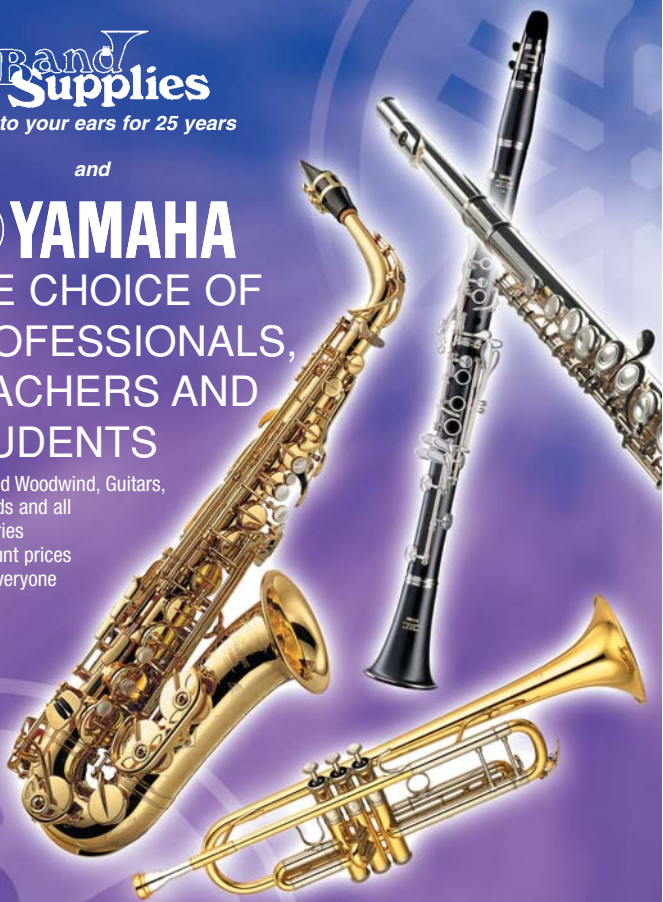

CAROLE SUTHERLAND Saxophone Course



Held in the stunning Lyth Arts Centre near Wick, Caithness, the Carole Sutherland Saxophone Course offers adult amateur saxophonists of all levels the chance to learn and perform with others in a supportive and relaxed environment. You don't have to be a whizz kid on the saxophone to attend the Course, although some previous playing experience would be helpful.

You will be put into groups with other participants of a similar standard. A series of classes will be offered over the weekend covering everything from improving your technique to playing in groups as well as general musicianship skills.

Ensembles

Rehearse and perform with other saxophonists in small and large groups.

Technique

Breathing, tone, articulation, vibrato...all you want to know about how to play the saxophone.

Musicianship

Effective practice, sight-reading, rhythm, ensemble playing and much more.

Piano Accompaniment

Working with a pianist to rehearse music with piano accompaniment. Individual rehearsal times will be allocated.

Individual Lessons NEW!

Receive expert tuition on a one-to-one basis. Limited availability so apply early!

Masterclass

Perform to an audience in an informal setting, with coaching from Carole. Piano accompaniment will be available for this class.

Improvisation NEW!

An introduction to the art of improvisation tailored for beginners as well as tips on how to improve for those who already have experience.

World Premiere NEW!

A brand new composition is being written by Ian Stewart specially for this year's Course. Participants will give the world premiere performance in the closing concert. Check out Ian's website at surfforms.co.uk.

As well as the classes, there will be an assortment of instruments and accessories made available by Band Supplies of Glasgow and Yamaha to try and buy as well as a selection of sheet music to top up your collection. The saxophone tutors will be on hand to answer any saxophone-related queries you may have at any point during the Course.

The Course will conclude with a short, informal concert on Sunday 28th at 4.30pm.
